Criterion	Score 0 – 6 0 = not at all met / poor, 6 = fully met / excellent
Relevance to the PEOPLE AMR network scope of (identifying better ways to) developing, evaluating and/or implementing interventions to promote prudent antimicrobial use in the community.	
Project and team are transdisciplinary (covering at least 3 research councils)	
Lead and team have demonstrated the required level of expertise to carry out the project	
Clarity of aims	
Match between methods and aims, and likelihood of yielding results that address the research question	
Feasibility (i.e. likelihood of project completing on time and providing results).	
Value for money	
Potential impact of the research	
Capacity building	
Strong engagement with people with lived experience of antimicrobial use/resistance in human and/or animal health care	
Value for money	
Overall score 6 = Fundable, Excellent 5 = Fundable, Good 4 = Fundable, Minor weaknesses/concerns 3 = Not fundable, Moderate weaknesses/concerns 2 = Not fundable, Significant weaknesses/concerns 1 = Not fundable, Severe weaknesses/concerns
