

- Cultural Psychiatry: epidemiology, anthropology, sociology
- Ethnic Inequalities of experiences and outcome of SMI
 - Methods:
 - Cultural narratives, illness perceptions/EMs, cultural identity, biographies/ethnography, spirituality, religiosity....
 - Community embedded recruitment to research, participatory methods
 - Outcomes : suicide, self-harm, depression, psychosis, personality disorder, violence, extremism, dementia
 - Outcome adaptation and validation
 - Cultural competency and consultation interventions
 - Adverse experiences such as discrimination/racism, migration, trauma (refugees); positive experiences: social support, identity, belonging.
 - Understanding coercive pathways through care and clinical assessment: criminal justice system involvement, **MHA**
 - Interventions: health literacy in populations, care pathways, assessment, engagement, cultural adaptation of interventions

Bio-Social Interface, Place, and Multiple Disadvantage

- Ethnicity and inequalities in psychosis incidence and care: lack of traction=lack of effective theory and practice
 - Evidence, coalitions and place-based systems work (B'ham, Leeds, Manch, Lond)
 - Influencing commissioning and policy and clinical practice
 - Using patient voice, narratives, creative arts to reframe and motivate actions
- Multimorbidity and premature mortality
 - MM: Detecting mental illness in MM (CKD, Cancer) and interventions
 - Understanding mechanisms by which adversity leads to Psychosis, MM, including mediation through inflammation
 - Role of ethnicity?
- Syndemics: better models of causation, prevention, and knowledge to build integrated care, where ethnicity is part of a syndemic
 - New application: HSRD, WT

Preventive Psychiatry/ Public Health

- Adolescent mental health
 - Cohorts: RELACH, DASH, REACH
 - Bullying, racism, social support, cultural identity, trauma
 - Self-harm, depression, anxiety
 - **ATTUNE**
- Complex Interventions: multicomponent for comorbidity and some including creative arts or e-intervention
 - SURECAN
 - ROSHNI
 - Internet based suicide prevention: Turkish samples London/Amsterdam
 - **Framers: GCRF** – digital resilience for youth and families (COVID-adapted)
 - **COVID**
 - **PHOSP-evolving**
 - **Warwick**
 - **Herts**
