EDGE2 STUDY: PATIENT NOTIFICATION

The EDGE2 study is recruiting patients admitted to this hospital. This research study is inviting patients with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) to use a digital self-management system. The self-management system is a tablet computer that patients use to complete a daily symptom diary that can create a picture of their health over time. In order to identify patients in this hospital that may be eligible to take part in the study, the research team perform searches through the electronic patient record to find patients that might be suitable. Patients who are eligible may be invited to take part in the study. Participation is voluntary and no identifiable patient data will leave the NHS Trust without written consent from the patient concerned.

The team will ask you to provide your full name and one other identifier (a piece of data used to identify you) for our records. We will need to retain these data points for the duration of the EDGE2 study in order to comply with your request. When the study ends your data will be destroyed. A member of the research team will also add a note of your dissent to your medical record.
