A literature review is when you read lots of things written by other people, and choose the things that are most useful for your topic.



One of our reviews will be on **older** people with learning disabilities and behaviours that challenge others.



The other review will be on **older family carers** of people with learning disabilities
and behaviours that challenge others.



In each review, we will look for articles or reports that talk about:



 people's physical and mental health;



• people's social care needs;



• services that can help people;



 information and resources that can help people.



We will write a report about what we have found out.



We will publish articles about what we have found out.



We will also write Easy Read summaries of what we found out.
