Many people with learning disabilities live at home with their Mum and Dad.



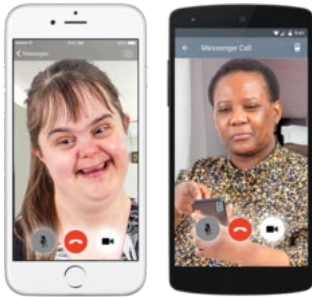
We want to find out what happens when Mum and Dad get too old, or die. Where will people live then?
