Merton College

Five items from the library at Merton College, Oxford.

Merton College Library has its origins in the 1270s when the college began building a collection of shared manuscript books for use by the fellows. Through donations, bequests, and purchases the number of books grew to over 1200 volumes by 1500. These were primarily books for study rather than for display or for private devotion. Of the 328 medieval manuscripts in the Merton library today, the vast majority were already in the college before the Reformation. The collection has a special significance

Featured Collection

Chinese Maps, Manuscripts and Printed Books

Over 1,000 items from the Bodleian's Chinese maps, manuscripts and printed books collections, acquired since the 17th century.

The Bodleian Library's Chinese collections date back to the earliest period of the Library's history. Si Thomas Bodley himself was instrumental in building up the collection, and during the following century the Library acquired other Chinese works from several bequests. The Bodleian now holds at many as a quarter of all the extant Chinese books that arrived in Europe in the 17th century.

Towards the end of the 19th century the Library acquired two large collections of missionary publications. These works have an interest which goes beyond their value as expositions of Christia doctrine: some are written in local dialects, others provide glimpses of the popular Chinese religiou and social customs which the missionaries encountered in the course of their work; all illustrate the process whereby traditional Chinese block-printing was gradually replaced by Western typography.


Digitized items include MS.Chin.c.15 and MS.Chin.c.37, two painted albums depicting the manners and customs of the peoples inhabiting mountainous regions of Yunnan, Guizhou and southwest China; and the Selden Map of China, one of the first Chinese maps to reach Europe.


RAW Search Queries in ORA, 2024-2025, by month


